a vast river separated my home and Sangiro Primary school. During the rain season (mi-November water from the April), mountains pours into Lake Malawi making it impossible to cross this river as there is no bridge. Most of the time, I would miss classes waiting

for the water levels to drop. However, I worked hard at my studies and was granted a place at the boarding school at Chilumba Secondary School. The next challenge was to pay my school fees and

the necessary fees, by the time I entered Form 2 (Grade 10), the struggle was becoming to great for her. Change Her World came to my rescue and I continued my education with this charity paying my school fees, uniform, solar lamp and other supplies.

With this support, it was no surprise that after completing Form 4 (Grade 12), I passed my National Exams with very high marks and qualified for University. In 2015, I was admitted to Exploits University (one of the pubuniversities)

60 Goats and Growing.....

The goats continue to multiply bringing much needed food and income to the 60 women and their families who will benefit when the rotation is completed. Upon completion of the rotation, the project committee will provide to the Board a detailed and comprehensive summary of the goat project. The project afforded many women the opportunity to acquire and use new skills, to begin an income growth opportunity and also experience the pride that comes with accomplishment.

Secondary and Post Secondary CHW Girls in Chilumba

In December 2017, our committee in Chilumba gathered most of the girls Change Her World is supporting in secondary school and university to distribute school supplies.

Construction continues on girls' hostel in Chilumba. An additional \$10,0000 US is required for cement, a roof, doors and windows to complete construction for this hostel which will accommodate 50 girls.

The tuition of a student in post secondary education is 3 times that of supporting a student in secondary school. We now have <u>26</u> students in post secondary institutions.

Fees for 1 year in secondary school

125 X 3 terms = 375.00 US/year

Tuition for 1 year in university \$400.00 x 3 terms = \$1,200.00 US/year

Upkeep: \$140.00 X 3 terms = \$420.00 US/year

Cost for 1 year at university =\$1,620.00 US
