This is an opportunity for current college and university students, as well as recent CHW graduates, to share their stories about their college and university experience. Also, local community professionals attend and offer information



about their varied careers. Often times, the girls may not know what their future career options are. It is a time to provide encouragement for the girls and reinforce the value in working hard and staying in school. It has been some time since an Empowerment gathering has been held but hopefully, we will be able to return to this practice yearly.

Zone Chair Meeting June 15 in Malawi

As you may be aware, when we started our work in the Chilumba area, our target area was divided into 6 zones with a zone chair and a committee of 10 people in each zone. **These people are the backbone of the organization in many ways** as they identify the neediest and most vulnerable in their particular area who would benefit immensely from support.

Two of these zones were quite large. Because it is a very rural area involving walking long distances, often over rough terrain, these particular zones have since been divided into an A and B zone. First to do this was Fulirwa Zone and more recently, Mazungamika Zone. Each Zone Chair was given a bicycle to help in travelling. Their primary function is to gather the



names of the needy in their assigned zone, identify those needs and then channel that information through to the main committee at the Office/Library in Chilumba. The committee in turn relays it to the Board for consideration and action. These people met in June at the CHW Chilumba Community Library for just these purposes. Below are photos of this most recent gathering.

As the complement of girls and women increases, more efficiency in following the progress of the girls is needed as well as tracking the other activities which have been done in the respective zones i.e. wells, school roofs, hostels, pig and goat projects.



Underwear Update!

On Thursday May 15 we officially reached, and exceeded, the goal of 20,000 pairs! Deliveries from Jackie Schidmt from London and Evelyn Arthur from Browns United Church helped us exceed the goal! The number of girls and women's underwear shipped as of June 2024: 20,189 pairs! Quite a milestone!

We did it!

Thanks to everyone who brought underwear to the dinner and to those who have handed it to us at various occasions and in a variety of venues!!!

Heading for 25,000 thousand pairs! We can do it! Yes, we can!
